



Fig. 3 - Typical Junction Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage (Per Leg)










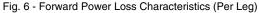

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


Fig. 7 - Maximum Non-Repetitive Surge Current (Per Leg)




Fig. 8 - Unclamped Inductive Test Circuit

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
