




Fig. 1 - Typical Output Characteristics




Fig. 3 - Typical Saturation Characteristics




Fig. 2 - Typical Transfer Characteristics




Fig. 4 - Maximum Safe Operating Area




Fig. 5 - Maximum Effective Transient Thermal Impedance, Junction-to-Case vs. Pulse Duration






Fig. 6 - Typical Transconductance vs. Drain Current




Fig. 9 - Normalized On-Resistance vs. Temperature




Fig. 7 - Typical Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage




Fig. 10 - Typical Capacitance vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage




Fig. 8 - Breakdown Voltage vs. Temperature




Fig. 11 - Typical Gate Charge vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage






Fig. 12 - Typical On-Resistance vs. Drain Current




Fig. 13 - Maximum Drain Current vs. Case Temperature




Fig. 14 - Power vs. Temperature Derating Curve




Fig. 15 - Clamped Inductive Test Circuit




Fig. 16 - Clamped Inductive Waveforms




Fig. 17a - Switching Time Test Circuit




Fig. 17b - Switching Time Waveforms






Fig. 18a - Basic Gate Charge Waveform





Fig. 18b - Gate Charge Test Circuit




Fig. 19 - For P-Channel
